• Does the poster give a clear explanation of the scientific and technical principles involved with reference to the diagrams on the poster?				
• Does the poster explain the significance and impact that the topic has on the real (everyday) world and this is shown in the diagrams and supporting text?				
• Are the scientific ideas and explanations accurate and correct?				
• Have I used at least three relevant diagrams? Are the diagrams either hand drawn or produced as originals by me using tools on a computer? <b>(Diagrams electronically copied or scanned are <u>not</u> acceptable, they must be original or hand drawn).</b>				
• Have I used my own words in the text? <b>(Copying text directly from software or the Web is plagiarism, and is unacceptable).</b>				
• Have I included any <u>References</u> I used <b>in a box at bottom right corner</b> of my poster (books, web sites, etc. used as background for my research)?				
<b>Presentation:</b>				
• Does the layout have a clear logical flow to the ideas presented with the information visually connecting together?				
• Are the diagrams and matching text easy to read with headings & labels distinguishable from a distance of 2 metres and content text distinguishable from a minimum of 1 metre?				
• Is my poster on paper/cardboard that can be easily rolled up and is its size larger than A2 size (60x40cm) and smaller than A1 size (80x60cm)				
• Have I stayed within the word limit (maximum 400 words)?				
• Have I shown any innovative and creative thought in the visual presentation?
