• Is the game well presented and packaged so that all the bits will be properly contained in the box and are not easily lost during transport?				
• Is the game self contained in a box attractively labeled with the games title on the outside, and the box has a maximum size of 25cm x 45cm with a depth of 14cm and the board size is smaller than A2 size (42cm x 60cm)				
• Have I shown any innovative and creative thought in the design and game play for the game, making it fun to play repeatedly?				
• Have I taken a photo of your game ready to give to the judges?				
• Overall presentation/ visual appeal and fun to play.
