As a Bursary winner in the 67th Science Talent Search, we strongly encourage you to exhibit your project at the public Exhibition and Presentation Day on Monday 29th October 2018 in the Union Hall at La Trobe University, Bundoora. It is very important that you take this letter with you on Exhibition Day for your own information. Please ensure early arrival as delays may be expected during registration.

**Class project winners** will have the bursary cheque allocated to the **school** on behalf of the student participants.

Please be sure to cash your cheque **before 30 June 2019**, as the account will be closed after this date and you cannot cash it. STS **does not re-issue** expired cheques. Any cheques requiring replacement before the expiry date will incur a \$15 **bank** fee, this is not a STS fee.

## REGISTRATION:

Before you can be awarded your Bursary, your **SCHOOL** must be registered by your teacher. If you are attending the Exhibition and Presentation Day with your teacher or with a supervising adult, make sure they give you your **OFFICIAL REGISTRATION NAME TAG**. This name tag allows the STS Committee to identify you during your Presentation Ceremony.
