

## **Posters-scientific wall charts – Lower Primary and Primary**

Congratulations to all those students who made the effort to compete in the poster section of the Science Talent Search.

This year 197 posters were entered with 109 from upper primary and 88 from the lower primary. Of those students who entered in the lower primary section eight received a major bursary and twelve received a minor bursary. In upper primary fourteen received a major bursary and twenty-nine received minors.

Students were asked to address one of the set topics – *Australian forests under the waves, adapting to bushfires, floods and extreme temperatures or why are our native species disappearing?* The judges felt that most posters were well set out and presented a good understanding of the scientific content relating to the topic.

On judging day the judges were impressed by the enthusiasm of the students and their understanding of the concepts presented on their posters.
